Do some reading at home every day.

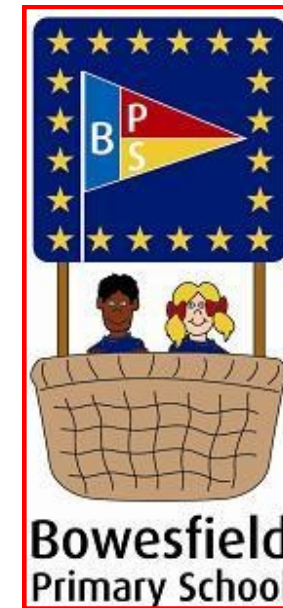
