What will you do in your spare time?

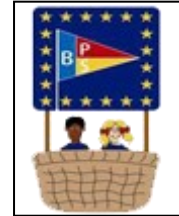
I have four grandchildren, I dragon boat and keep fit, I like to read books and work on the allotment.
