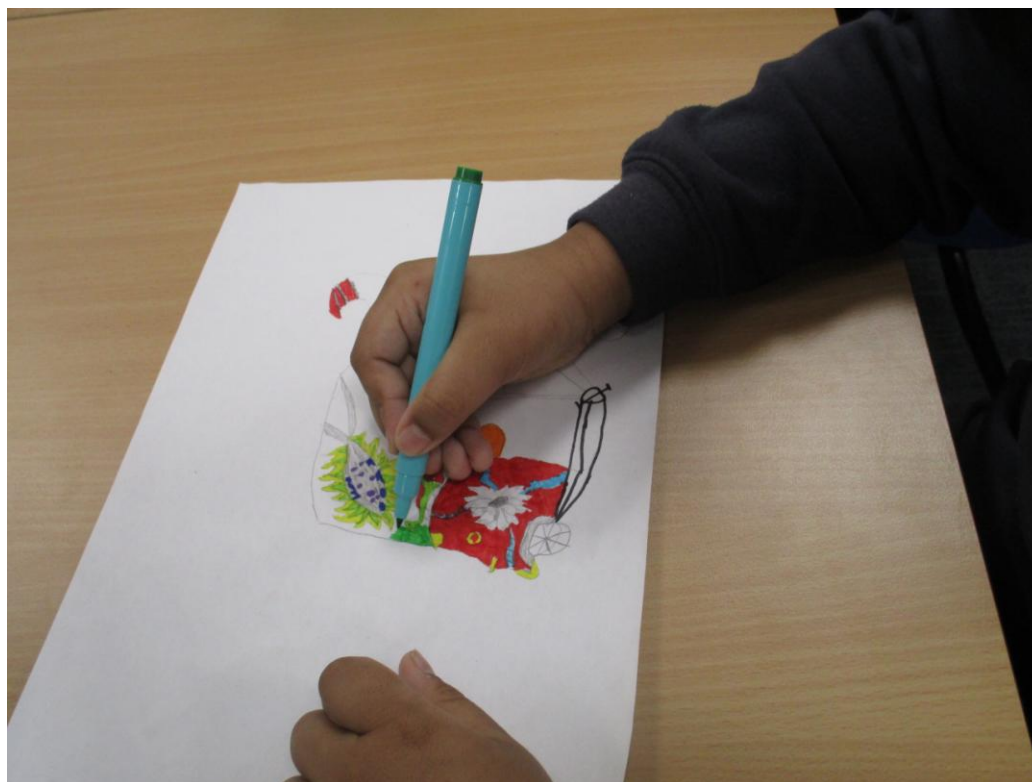


To celebrate International Mother Tongue Day on Wednesday 21st February 2018, we spent the day participating in different activities, looking at different countries, their culture, faith and rights.

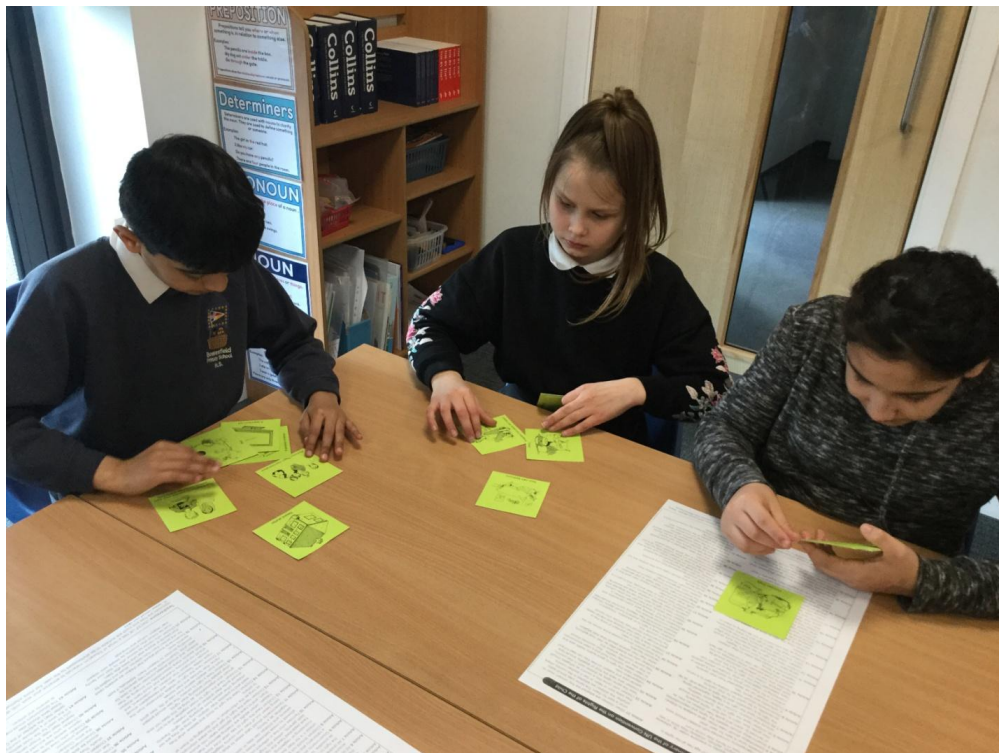
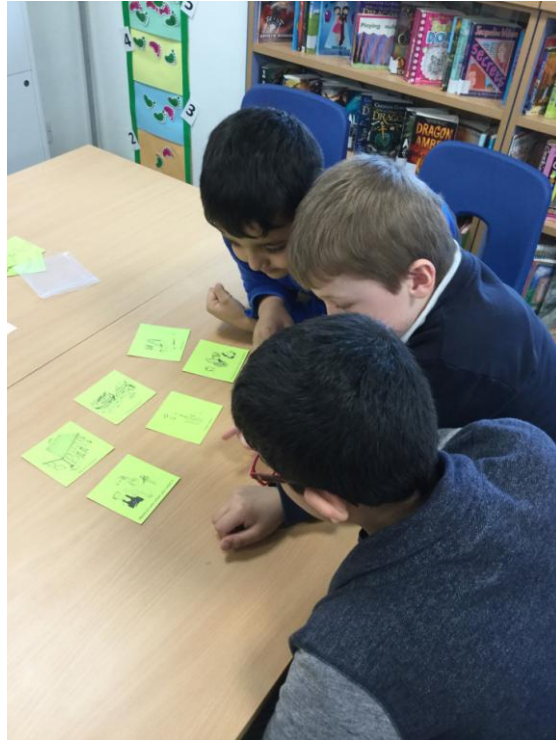
