French curriculum vision

At Bovesfield Primary School, many children speak at least one other language in addition to English.

Learning an additional modern foreign language provides an additional educational, social and cultural experience. It helps them to further develop communication skills, including key skills of speaking and listening, extending their knowledge of how languages work.

Learning another language gives children a new perspective on the world, encouraging them to explore their own cultures and those of others. Children can begin to explore the origins of words and the similarities and differences between French and English.

At Bovesfield, learning a modern foreign language begins in Y3 and children have a weekly lesson.

To support teaching and learning in French, we use resources from 'Rigalo' and 'Lightbulb Languages'.
