History curriculum vision:

We want children to develop their sense of place in the world through an understanding of how life in Britain has been shaped and changed over time. Children will begin to understand events which have shaped British culture, how society is influenced by events.

Children will:

- Develop a rich vocabulary – encounter words relating to the past, yesterday, last year, 19th century, as well as talking about groups of people – e.g. Romans, Vikings.
- Visit a range of places and have a wide range of cultural experiences – visits to local places of interest which have historical significance – Preston Hall, James Cook Birthplace Museum, Warkworth Castle, Segedunum Roman Fort.
- Engage with visitors invited into school – e.g. historical figures, representatives of British Legion.
- Reflect on significant historical events in assemblies, in class and during whole school events.
- Develop a thirst for historical knowledge and enjoy sharing this with others, for example in a museum presentation.
- Build on prior learning and make links across areas of learning in history and across the curriculum.
