Dear Parent/Carers

In Year One during the summer term, your child will be given the



opportunity to participate in forest schools—engaging in outdoor activities regardless of the weather. Please make sure your child comes appropriately dressed. This takes place on a Monday. afternoon.

For PE this half term, your child can continue to come dressed for their lesson on a Monday and Friday but after half term, they need to be able to change into their school PE kits. Please practise dressing with your child as they need to be able to do this quickly.

Curriculum:

In Maths, we will be learning about multiplication and division, fractions, position and

direction, place value to 100 time and money. To help your child, you could show them times on the clock related to the hour and half past.
