Below is a brief outline of the work your child will be involved in during this term. If you would like any more information, please contact the class teacher.

English	English this term will link the text 'There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom.' Children will continue to develop their writing through visual clips, quality texts and drawing on their own experiences. They will learn how to build tension and suspense when writing a Greek myth. They will also look closely at explanation texts and the grammatical structures within them, so they can then write their own.
Maths	Children will develop their understanding of line graphs. We will be continuing to develop addition, subtraction, multiplication and division skills using larger numbers. Children will also continue to develop speed and accuracy when learning their times tables up to 12 x 12. Please encourage your child to use Times Tables Rock Stars to help secure facts we are learning in class.
Science	Through practical enquiry, children will learn about Forces and Magnets. They will consider unsupported objects fall to the ground. They will learn about the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction.
Computing	During computing sessions, children will learn how to this term will focus on e-safety and develop a greater understanding of the impact that sharing digital content can have.
Religious Education	Learning this term will link to views about Christmas. Here children will look closely at how Christmas is celebrated by others.
Design Technology	Children will investigate and vary ingredients used to a Greek Salad to produce a salad using ingredients of their choice.
Art and Design	Children will develop their own media using collage. The children will investigate and combine their own materials to create a mixed media collage. After half term, children will be developing their drawing skills by selecting and enlarging drawings using pastels, pencil, and charcoal.
Music	Children will learn continue to develop a steady beat. Develop rhythm by copying simple patterns and developing their understanding pulse. They will also learn how to play the glockenspiel linked to music they will be listening to in class.
Physical Education	Children will look closely at health and fitness during PE sessions.
PSHE	The topic this term is Celebrating Difference. The children will look closely at racism and how to manage their feelings if racism occurs.
