Our Learning

Maths

At the beginning of this term, we will be consolidating our knowledge of fractions. We have begun by adding proper fractions and mixed numbers. We are now focusing on multiplying and dividing fractions by integers and other fractions. In a few weeks, we will move on to learn about decimals and percentages and finally algebra.

English

In VIPERS, we are reading 'Pig Heart Boy' by Malorie Blackman. We will use the text to practice the reading skills of: vocabulary, inference, prediction, explanation, retrieval and summary.

Pig Heart Boy will be used as a stimulus for writing.

Geography

Our geography lessons this half term are based on the theme 'Frozen Kingdom'. We have started by learning about the Arctic and Antarctic and we will compare and contrast the regions. Afterwards, we will learn about the biomes of the Polar regions and the effect that global warming has upon our Polar regions.

Science

This term, Year 6 will be learning about 'Living Things and Their Habitats'. We will be classifying animals and putting them into groups according to similarities and differences. Pupils will be able to give reasons for classifying animals and plants based on specific characteristics e.g. vertebrates, invertebrates, flowering plants, and non-flowering plants.
