#### Uniform

We are noticing a decline in children wearing the correct uniform each day. Each day your child should be wearing: a white shirt, blue jumper/ cardigan and grey trousers or skirt. School shoes should be black.

On PE days children should come to school wearing their PE kit. This is plain blue jogging bottoms and a plain white shirt. Children should not be wearing football tops or branded sportswear. No jewellery except small stud earrings are allowed in school. This is for your child's own safety. On PE days, children should not be wearing earrings unless they can remove them independently.
