Spring 1 Theme – Superb Stockton

Our geography theme for this term is ‘Superb Stockton’. Pupils will become geographers by will creating ordinance survey maps of both Stockton High Street and another high street close by. Furthermore, we will discuss both similarities and differences in the human and physical features of both High Streets.

Spring 2 Theme – Smashing Saxons

As historians, we will discover why the Anglo-Saxons and Scots invaded Britain. As authors, we will explain who the Anglo-Saxons and Scots were. As artists, we will be creating an Anglo-Saxon structure using recycled materials.

English

This term, we will begin by reading ‘Anglo-Saxon Boy’. We will use this text as well as stimulus such as Matilda as a basis for writing: Play script (to entertain), Leaflet (to persuade), Non-chronological report (to inform) and Formal letter (to persuade)

Maths

During mathematics this term, we will continue to consolidate our understanding and use of place value, addition and subtraction. We will then move onto learning about: Multiplication and Division. Length and Perimeter.

Science

Spring 1 – Animals including Humans

Children are expected to know: the function of the digestive system in humans, different types of teeth and identify producers, predators and prey.

Spring 2 – States of Matter

Children are expected to know: Materials are grouped in solids liquids and gases, some materials can change when heated or cooled and Understand evaporation and condensation in the water cycle.
