School Site Safety and Arrangements

Our main priority in school is your child/ children's safety.

We have many ways to safeguard your children throughout school from key fob entry and exit to adults on the schools gates, but we need your help too.

You may have noticed reminder signs on the gates asking you to close the gate behind you, we also ask that you do not hold the gate open for other parents or visitors. If you have done this in the past you believe you are being helpful and courteous but please allow that adult or child to press the buzzer so we can check their identity first.

All children and parents must use the side gates to enter school unless you are coming arriving after 8:50am.

Dropping off children

Please can we remind all families that children from Y1-Y6 should be dropped off at the side gates and allowed to walk round with their peers but children in reception must be brought to the classroom by an adult.
